## RPS Hopes & Dreams

At the conclusion of our most recent board meeting, I posed the following questions to Pam Crank and Amanda Clark: To Pam I asked, "What accomplishments or memories do you treasure most as you reflect on your time as Executive Director?" To Amanda I asked, "What are your hopes and dreams for RPS as you assume your new role?"

Pam began by stating she considered it a great privilege to have lead RPS, a ministry that belongs to God, and how she used Proverbs 3:5-6 to guide her each day "Trust in the LORD WITH ALL THINE HEART; AND LEAN NOT UNTO THINE OWN UNDERSTANDING. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths." She reflected on the early periods of financial instability and how there were times when making payroll was nearly impossible. Needless to say, she is extremely grateful that those years are behind us.

As the ministry continued to grow, it became necessary to consider new technology and a larger building. In 2011, a new ultrasound machine was purchased. A successful capital campaign enabled RPS to purchase and remodel our current building in 2014, and a second 3D ultrasound machine was purchased in 2018. Two other significant accomplishments involved the opening of our satellite office on the OSU/NCSC campus to serve the student body and the launch of the "COMMIT"

program designed to reach young women age twelve through 18, with the message of sexual integrity.

Amanda's hopes centered on the ministry's continued success in sharing the gospel, saving the lives of the unborn, and building strong relationships with area churches. Amanda said, "I want RPS to be the first stop for anyone contemplating their pregnancy options or who may be tempted to compromise their sexual integrity. When these individuals come through the doors, I want them to feel the love God has for them, through the compassion of our staff and volunteers."

I, like all of you, appreciate Pam's dedication and compassionate service during her nine years as Executive Director. No one accepts a position at a pregnancy center for the economic benefits. They do it to serve our Lord, and to demonstrate a servant's heart to those who seek wise counsel, and Pam was no different. To her I also say, "Well done, good and faithful servant" Matthew 25:23.

To Amanda I extend a heartfelt welcome from all of us at RPS. We are so grateful that the Lord has gifted you with so much talent and a heart for the unborn. We pray that you too, will one day look back on your time as Executive Director with fond memories and an awareness of the abundant blessing the Lord has provided.

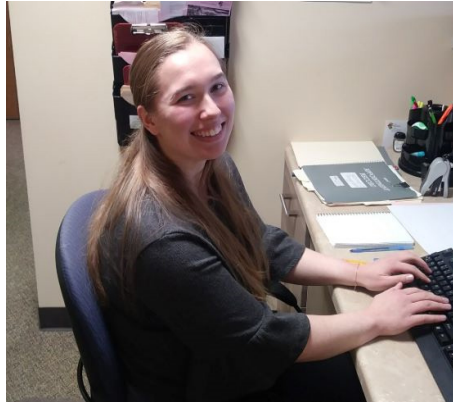


## Welcome New RPS Team Member
