As you may know, our plans to open a satellite office in Ocie Hill was short Ocie Hill, we had a community clean-up day in which we got the room September, God could still be glorified if we could even just help one client grow her confidence in her parenting and have materials to ensure that her baby had all that he or she needed. One meeting led to another. On Friday, July 17th, we held our very first appointment and ultrasound at our City Center satellite location! We knew God was leading us

to downtown Mansfield, and even though plans didn't go as we had foreseen, He made the outcome better than we could imagine! We have a beautiful room to work in where we can share about our services, offer pregnancy testing and verification (for WIC & Medicaid), and we can offer our free ultrasounds (90% of women will choose life when they see their baby on the ultrasound if they were previously considering abortion)!
