For many years, Richland Pregnancy Services has served clients Monday -Thursday and two Saturdays each month. Because of your support RPS is now open to clients two additional days each month! RPS will be open the first and third Friday of the month from 10:00 am - 4:00 pm to serve women and men facing a pregnancy decision! These days are critical because Fridays are being targeted as the days that are "best" for women to take the abortion pill. RPS will now be open during these times to offer life-affirming alternatives to that message!

More than \$18,000 Raised for RPS Through Richland Gives

Richland Gives is held every year on Giving Tuesday (The Tuesday after Thanksgiving). The Richland County Foundation coordinates this giving opportunity for area nonprofits.

This year more than **160 donors** gave \$12,683 to RPS through Richland Gives! This allowed RPS to earn \$6,250 in bonus grants for **a total of \$18,933**! These funds will go directly toward life saving services and programs offered at RPS, such as free pregnancy testing and verification, ultrasounds, mom-to-mom and dad-to-dad mentoring, abortion recovery, parenting classes, STD testing and treatment and material support!

Dad-to-Dad Mentoring Changes Lives By Dick Stedman, Dad-to-Dad Director

Recently, a male client stopped by RPS because he wanted to schedule a special two-hour session with me. He specifically wanted to learn more about the Bible. This client had been faithfully attending sessions with me and another mentor dad for nearly 16 months.

When he came in, I asked if he wanted some of the time to continue with a DVD we had previously started, but he was intent on learning more about the Bible. For the next 90 minutes, I shared several Bible lessons and documents with him.

When it came time to end the session, I asked him if there was anything that I could pray for. His response was sincere and eager, "Could you explain to me how I can become a Christian?"

We trust God to bring about these moments as we interact with clients, knowing that with Christ in their heart and life, their lives will be completely changed. He repeated after me the sinners' prayer and joyfully thanked me for guiding him in this prayer to accept Jesus as his Lord and Savior.
